- Their attitudes and emotion, e.g. angry, quiet, strong willed.
- Personal qualities, build, hair, voice, face, age
- Costume, naturalism.
- The way they present themselves, walk, stand, talk.
- The relationship between the character and the audience. How do you want the audience to feel about this character?

Write down every section this character appears in and who they appear with. Make a note of this somewhere in your book to make it easier in your exam.
